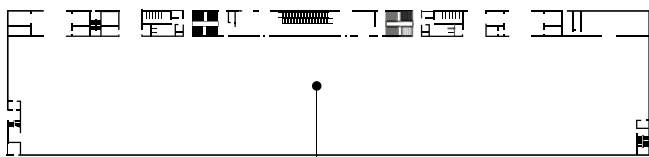




Hall 36 is an open, industrial-style space on the upper level of the South Halls. It regularly hosts exhibitions, trade fairs and gala events. The ceiling structure offers a wide range of possibilities for hanging and partitioning the area, allowing for flexible use of the space. A comprehensive network of channels facilitates the installation of electrical, water, and IT systems to suit a variety of needs. The space also benefits from practical logistical access at ground level, as well as a large, glazed visitors' entrance that looks out over the gardens. The sustainable building of Hall 36 boasts a large number of windows, ensuring an abundance of natural light throughout the space.

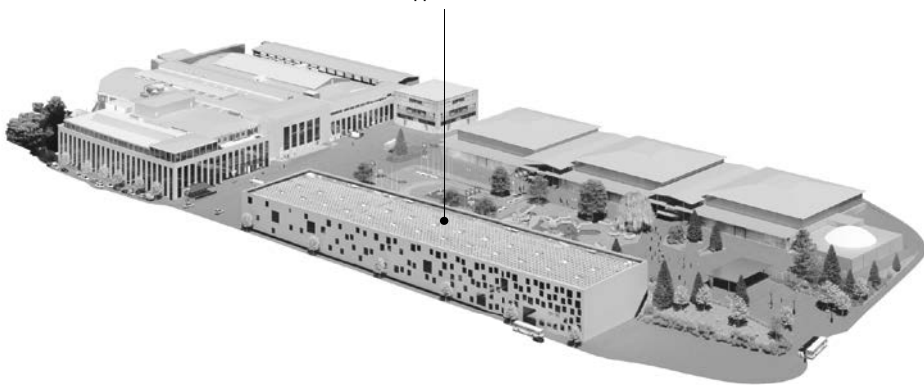
